Transfer Requests

Any students living outside the Parkview boundaries must file for a transfer approval every year in order to attend Parkview schools. This transfer request form must be turned in to the Administration building by May 13th. Request forms are available through the Parkview school offices. Decisions on transfers will be made in June. Decisions on Kindergarten transfers will not be made until district numbers can be evaluated.

SUMMER - FREE MEALS

Once again this summer, beginning June 4 through July 20, FREE MEALS will be offered to all children ages 18 and younger at Parkview Primary and Lincoln Elementary School. Dollen/OMS will also provide FREE MEALS for the month of June 4-29, with an option to be open in July. (BMS will not be a meal site this summer.) Breakfast will be served from 9:00 - 10:00 and lunch from 11:30 - 1:00. Adults may eat breakfast for \$2.10 and lunch for \$3.30. This is dine-in only.
